Bring your friends to the Kenelm Meeting on September 21st, which starts at 5.00pm. In addition to the passing of W. Bro. Jay Shah's son Bro. Vishal Shah, we will be presenting certificates to W. Bro. John Grant and W. Bro. John Detre to celebrate their 40 years in the Lodge,

After an introduction and update by W. Bro. Tony Shields representing the Metropolitan Cyberknife Appeal, there will be a presentation of a cheque for £1000 to the appeal. Most of this sum was raised at the Kenelm Golf Tournament, in which Metropolitan Lodge, Humility with Fortitude was involved.

The CyberKnife is not actually a knife at all. It's a state-of-the-art piece of equipment that allows specialist oncologists to treat tumours and other medical conditions painlessly without the need for an operation. CyberKnife uses pencil beams of radiation which can be directed at any part of the body from any direction via a robotic arm. The robotic arm tracks the tumour's position, detects any movement of the tumour or patient, and automatically corrects its positioning before targeting the tumour with multiple beams of high-energy radiation, destroying abnormal tissue without damaging surrounding areas. The treatment is so accurate that it's now possible to treat tumours previously thought to be inoperable. Although the results of treatment do not always show immediately, in most cases the procedure will initially stop the growth of tumours before gradually reducing their size.
