THE LODGE MENTOR

At the Quarterly Communications meeting at Freemasons Hall on December 14th, the Pro. Grand Master, Peter Lowndes set out the thinking on Mentoring:-

“Brethren - Mentoring has been high on the agenda for some time and I want to take this opportunity to give clarity and perspective to what we mean by mentoring.....Initially this is especially for candidates – the next generation – during the three degrees and then to encourage them to continue their progress into the Royal Arch.

“In an ideal world, mentoring would happen naturally anyway and that everyone would be looked after as a matter of course, and that this, in turn, would take care of issues such as recruitment, retentionone of the aims we should all keep in mind is the promotion of an environment of belonging, understanding, involvement and enjoyment within the Lodge.”
